Important Other Information

The current National Minimum Wage (NMW) rate for apprentices is £3.30 per hour. This applies to 16-18 year old apprentices and those aged over 19 in the first year of their Apprenticeship. For all other apprentices the National Minimum wage appropriate to their age applies. The Minimum Wage for Apprentices applies to time spent on the job plus time spent training.

- * Please note that anyone over the age of 18 may be offered to work over 40 hours per week *
- *Please note if the successful applicant is found prior to the closing date the vacancy maybe withdrawn early*

The post-holder must be working towards gaining their driving licence by the end of the apprenticeship in order to eventually move vehicles as part of the role.

The apprentice will be expected to purchase basic tools throughout the apprenticeship duration to build up their own kit.

The candidate must be available to start immediately and be able to travel to the workplace according to the working hours.
